The theme of this year's SRM is "Harnessing the Immune System" and will highlight the translation of scientific advances in human immunology to fighting cancer, guiding vaccine development, and development of more effective treatments for autoimmune disorders and lung disease. For the Joint Plenary session on Monday morning, February 12th, Dr. Stephania Cormier from the University of Tennessee will address "Respiratory Immunology in Response to Viruses and Environmental Toxins" and Dr. Gregg Silverman from New York University will provide insights on "Lupus and the Microbiome".

In addition to our excellent standing program (http://www.ssciweb.org/meeting-schedule.php), we have opportunities for interactive learning through workshops on Saturday afternoon, February 11th that include "Manuscript Preparation and Peer-Reviewed Publication" and "Moving your Clinical Case Presentation into a Published Manuscript". We are continuing the Meet the Experts Breakfast on Sunday morning, February 12 and holding an extended workshop on "Career Development for Clinician Educators" on Sunday afternoon.

At SRM 2017, we will be presenting 137 student and trainee travel awards, honoring the SSCI Young Investigators, SSCI Mentors of the Year, and the Tinsley Harrison Award recipient. In addition, **Dr. David** Guidot, an outstanding leader and mentor in academic medicine and longstanding supporter of the mission of SSCI, will be presented the prestigious SSCI Founders' Medal at the SSCI Presidential Symposium on Sunday morning.
